Overview costs first year students Hotel Management 2026-2027

Below you will find an overview of costs you may expect during your first year of the Hotel Management (HM) study programme at the Hospitality Business School (HBS). The costs mentioned in this overview are an indication. No rights can be derived from this overview.

1. Tuition fee

Every student, who registers for a course at the university, needs to pay tuition fees. For the academic year 2026-2027 this amount is set at € 2.694. This amount applies for a full-time course. For students outside the EU region, please visit <https://www.saxion.edu/> for the 'fee structure'.

2. Dress code during occasions

In the hospitality sector it is highly valued to be dressed appropriately for the occasion. All first year Hotel Management students purchase a dark blue suit.

- Man's clothing: the set consists of a dark blue suit, a white shirt and tie.
- Woman clothing: the set consists of a dark blue blazer and, optionally, a skirt or trousers and a white blouse.

The Hospitality Business School works with a preferred supplier, Kayser Clothing in Enschede, but of course you are free to purchase the same package elsewhere. At Kayser Clothing the amount for a set is approximately € 325 - € 380*.

You do not have to purchase any clothing yet. Further information will follow during the Saxion Introduction Week.

Please note: you can combine the suit with clean white sneakers. The tie (only for men) that you wear with the above clothing set is purchased by HBS. During the course you will receive a personal name badge that you need to wear on your clothing at different occasions.

3. Credits abroad (for Dutch students only)

As a student of Hotel Management, you are obliged to gain at least 30 European Credits (EC) abroad. Depending on the education activities you would like to follow abroad to obtain these credits, there are costs involved.

4. Study trips

During your study, several study trips are an integral part of modules. You are expected to participate in the study trips. The modules are linked to substantive assignments, which through the study trips need to be completed. The costs of the study trips vary per course and academic year. In the first year of your studies, you should consider the amount of approximately € 449. The Hotel Management study programme offers one study trip in the first year.

5. Excursions

As a student you can participate in various excursions and company visits. The costs of these excursions should be paid by you, including the travel expenses.

6. Study Association

Within the Hotel Management program, the study association Promaître is the perfect place to further develop yourself, both personally and professionally.
